People will have to rely on each other to meet the immediate life saving and life sustaining needs, *particularly* in isolated neighborhoods that may be cut off from the main roads for a period of time.

The **County of Los Angeles Fire Department's Community Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.)** program was developed to provide basic training in safety and life saving skills for the general public.
