This building WILL NOT be used for high-piled combustible storage as defined in Article 2 of the County of Los Angeles Fire Code. Stockpile heights will not exceed 12 FEET in solid piles, in racks or on pallets; or 6 FEET when consisting of highly combustible or flammable material such as rubber, Group A plastic, flammable liquid, idle pallets and similar high-hazard commodities.

This building WILL be used for high-piled combustible storage and will conform to the requirements of Article 81 of the County of Los Angeles Fire Code.
