### 2009 OPEN FIRE SEASON PRESS CONFERENCE

- WHO:** Fire Chief P. Michael Freeman, representatives from the United States Forest Service, Cal Fire Department, Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Los Angeles County Fire Department, Orange County Fire Authority, Santa Barbara County Fire Department, Ventura County Fire Department, Los Angeles Fire Department, and San Bernardino County Fire Department, and Chief Officers Representatives of Region 6.
- WHAT:** **Media Event** will be hosted by the County of Los Angeles Fire Department and other wildland fire protection agencies in Southern California. The focus of the meeting is discuss elements of the 2009 Fire Season and Outlook and the introduction of a *NEW!* Wildfire Action Plan for residents living in High Risk Fire Areas known as **Ready, Set, Go!** There will be an opportunity to ask questions of Chief Officers of the departments represented, about the upcoming fire season and concerns for specific geographical areas. There will also be forestry and Fire Behavior Analyst from the Los Angeles County Fire Department to answer wildland related questions.
