Things of Note:

- **New Record set for Ocean Rescues with 15,851. Breaking Previous mark of 14,096 set in 1997.**
- **Second highest Estimated Beach Attendance ever with nearly 20 million more attendance than our average. (1rst was 2012 / 75.8 million)**
