HOW TO MANAGE PROPANE TANKS AND CYLINDERS IN AREAS AFFECTED BY WILDFIRE

If you had to evacuate due to the wildfire, there are certain steps to be taken upon returning to your home.

- Do not drive your vehicle directly up to your home following a wildfire.
- If you smell gas, leave the area immediately. Do not attempt to inspect the situation yourself.
- Do not open any appliance valves, gas valves or propane tank service valves.
- If your tank appears to be leaking, please call 911 and your propane service provider.

If your propane tanks or cylinders were affected by the wildfire, they will be evaluated by our Department or the Department of Toxic Substances Control as part of our hazardous waste assessments that will be occurring over the next few weeks.
